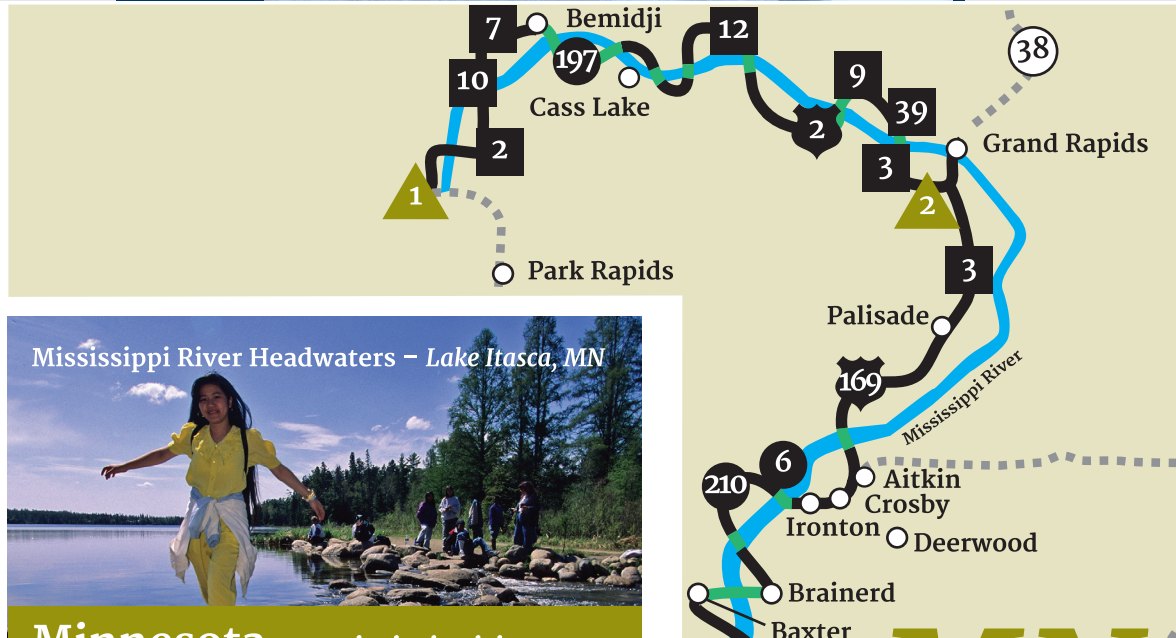
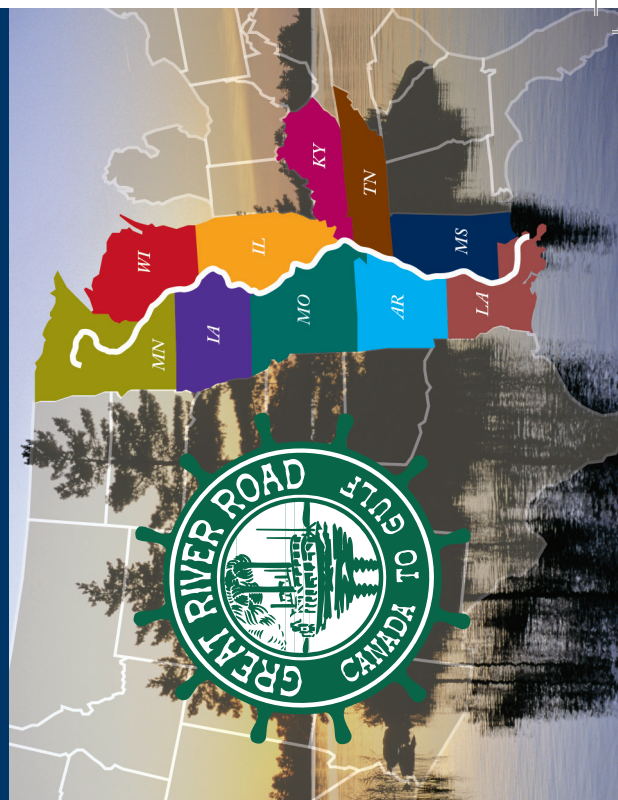

Great River Road Interpretive Centers

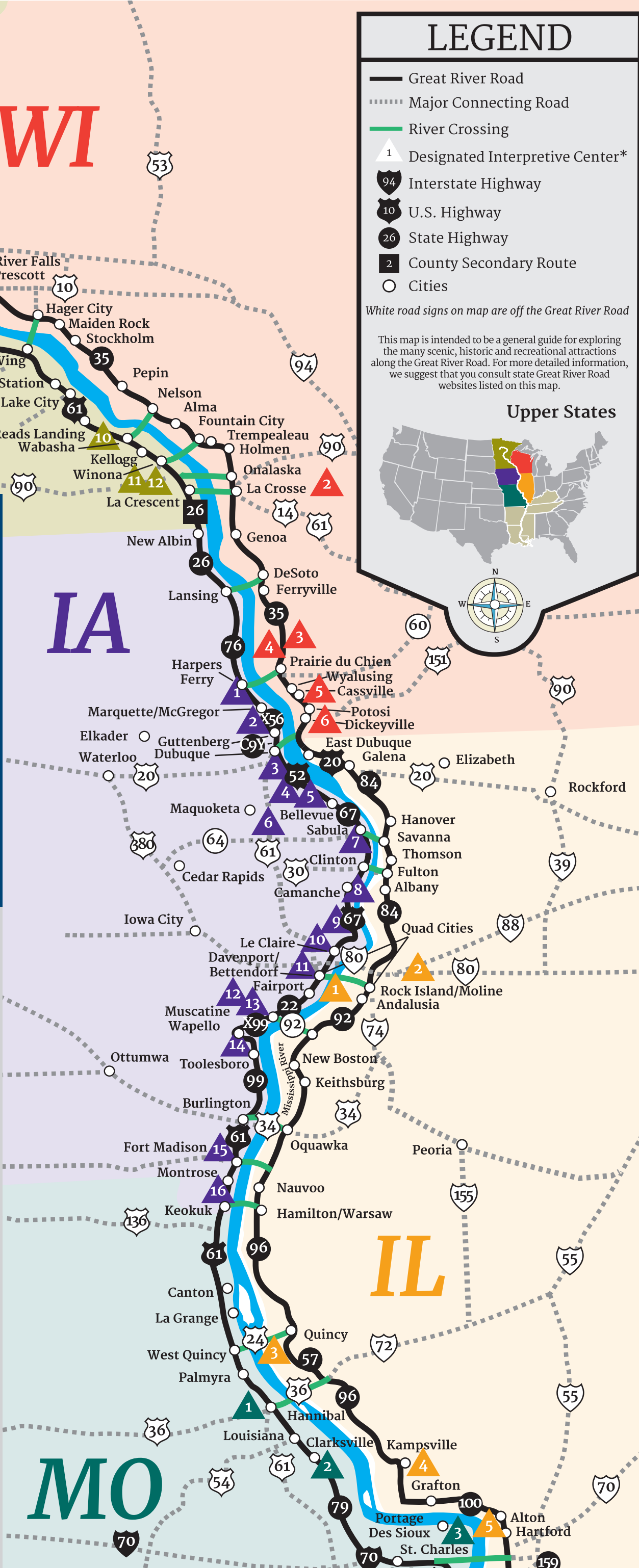
