- All-American Road Designation (AARD) Transportation committee reported that the deadline is still May 15. States are busy with requests for input and review. FHWA added some flexibility in language. The Transportation committee is meeting tomorrow at 2pm and then again at the discretion of the committee to meet the deadline. CMP initiatives will follow. We are specifically looking at wayfinding and what that means for each state. Lindsey is the new committee Co-Chair with Francis.
- Organizational Work Pilot Pro Tem shared that the endowment committee has not met yet and that this year is off to a financial roller coaster. State reports will be due September 1. Let us know of any state needs. AAR is part of the CMP, which is part of our strategic plan.
- **2020** Annual Meeting –MN-MRPC will be meeting in early June to further discuss the annual meeting staying as an in-person meeting or moving to virtual. MN looks forward to everyone traveling to the headwaters as well as celebrating AAR. If 2020 is not possible, MN will request to host in 2021.
- National Office First Quarter Report National office provided an overview of their first quarter report.
- Other Business Carol announced this would be her last board meeting as she officially passes the transportation chair baton to Francis and Lindsey. Everyone thanked Carol for her many years of leadership. Karl announced that he is teaching an online grant writing and fund development class through St Cloud State on April 28 if anyone is interested in participating. A few board members participated on the National Scenic Byway Foundation Webinar a few weeks ago on funding efforts and indicated it was positive.
