Signage: Each state should check signage for their ICs. An affordable business for procuring a sign should be presented to any site that has no sign .

Passport: Encourage each state to consider a Passport for visiting all their ICs. Iowa has had success with their passports.

Ambassador Training. For Orientation/ Awareness/Education states should conduct training for all ICs. Ambassador Training is available for downloading on the Minnesota MRPC web site. The training could be customized for each state.

Rack Cards: Consider reprinting the Rack Cards that lists similar sites along the GRR. If rack cards aren't possible, maybe a website location indicating similar centers could be designed.

IC yearly training: Consider a yearly Interpretive Center Manager training. In large states or those with a large number of sites far apart training might have to be conducted in more than one session.. At the training (in person or Zoomed) and along with overall topics, the **checklist** could be discussed and filled out.

Pollinator program: all IC's should be encouraged to participate.
